Equal Pay Day is the symbolic day where women's earnings "catch up" to men's earnings from the year before. A woman's male counterpart must work five days per week for twelve months, whereas she will work seven days per week for sixteen months to earn equivalent wages.

In Idaho, women earn about 76 cents for each dollar that men earn. This 24 percent pay gap puts "women in the red" for a lifetime.
