A 501(c)(3) organization, the WCA has served the Treasure Valley for over 100 years, providing safety, healing, and freedom to individuals and families experiencing domestic abuse and sexual assault. All services are free, long-term, trauma-informed, and wraparound, including support through their 24-hour hotline. Domestic abuse remains the leading cause of homelessness in Idaho and continues to rise, particularly in rural communities. This presentation will highlight what they are seeing locally and statewide, and how the WCA is working to address this

ongoing crisis.



Bre Young is the Philanthropy Manager for the WCA. She has served the WCA for five years, bringing deep expertise and compassion to her work overseeing volunteers, events, donations, and community engagement. The mission of the WCA is deeply personal to Bre, as loved ones in her life are survivors of domestic abuse and sexual assault. Seeing the impact of the WCA's work each day fuels her commitment to bridging gaps for survivors and helping create a community rooted in safety and healing.
